## RULES & GUIDELINES

### MASKS ARE MANDATORY

#### EFFECTIVE ON SEPTEMBER 20, 2021

Everyone over the age of 18 is required to provide proof of vaccination, proof of a negative PCR/ Rapid test, or documentation of a medical exemption to enter RCS Twin Rinks. Partial vaccination (one dose) will be accepted until October 25, 2021 if received 2 weeks prior to the day of entry. After October 25, 2021, full vaccination (two doses) will be required 2 weeks prior to the day of entry.

#### ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF VACCINATION

- Must be accompanied with photo ID.
- Paper Record – Received at time of immunization
- Digital Record - MyHealth Records (screen shot, web-based application)
- Vaccination Card – First Nations Cards, Pharmacy Cards, Government Cards

#### PROOF OF NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULTS

- Must be accompanied with photo ID.
- Tests must be privately paid COVID-19 PCR or rapid tests completed within 72 hours of entry.
- Alberta Health Services or Alberta Precision Laboratories will not be accepted.

\*Once an RCHL player provides proof of full vaccination, our staff will record it so future entries only require Government issued ID.

#### FACILITY RULES & PROTOCOLS

- Everyone over the age of 18 is required to provide proof of vaccination, proof of a negative PCR / Rapid test, or documentation of a medical exemption to enter RCS Twin Rinks.
- Everyone must wear a face mask in common areas (except on the ice).
- Physical distancing of 6 feet must be maintained at all times, with the exception of being on the ice.
- No entry is permitted at the north entrance (only used as an exit).
- Individuals under the age of 18 must get screened at the office each time they enter the facility.
